# SECURITY SCREENING IS COMPULSORY

When you enter a screening point, by law you are taken to consent to each screening procedure other than a frisk search. You are unable to choose your method of screening.

You may be asked to consent to a frisk search, including if you alarm in a sensitive area. If you wish to undergo the frisk search in a private room, you will be required to provide written consent.

A support person may accompany you for a frisk search in a private room.
